# Indian River Lagoon Seining



Wade into the waters of the Indian River Lagoon and explore the most biologically diverse estuary in North America.



## Program Description

Visitors will learn about the Indian River Lagoon and the importance of this unique estuary. Visitors will then have the opportunity to explore its biodiversity. Using seine nets, visitors will discover the animals that live in the various habitats including seagrass beds and mangrove tangles. A water quality test will also be demonstrated.
